

The following changes were made to the 2020 Medical Fee Schedule (MFS), resulting in the Initial Draft of the 2022 MFS.

#### **General Updates**

**Update for Medical Inflation** – The maximum fees for all codes that were included on the 2020 MFS and remain on the 2022 MFS were increased by approximately 5.37% for two years of medical inflation.

Removal of CPT/HCPCS Codes Retired as of January 1, 2021 – The 2022 MFS was developed to include only those codes which are valid as of January 1, 2021. Therefore, any CPT/HCPCS codes retired prior to January 1, 2021 were removed from the 2022 MFS.

Addition of New 2020 and 2021 Codes Crosswalked from a Code Currently on the MFS – CPT/HCPCS codes that were new in 2020 or 2021 were added to the 2022 MFS if the following conditions were met: (1) the new 2020 or 2021 code represents one that the American Medical Association crosswalked from a previously active code and the previously active code was terminated, and (2) the previously active code being crosswalked to a new 2020 or 2021 code appeared on the 2020 MFS.

Adjustments to the Maximum Fee to Reflect a Revised Definition in 2020 or 2021 – CPT codes, per the American Medical Association, and DRG codes, per the US Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, that were identified as having a revised definition in 2020 or 2021 had their maximum fee adjusted to reflect the new definition.
